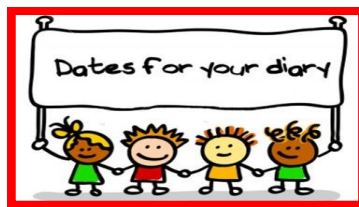

End of Centenary of World War One

Primary Schools' Art Competition

As part of its own commemoration of the End of the Centenary of World War One, the Council recently held a Schools' Art Competition for all three Primary Schools in the Village.

A large number of excellent and most creative entries were received and subsequently judged by Members of the Council's dedicated Working Party. The Winners' and Runners-Up Entries all received Book Tokens. In addition, each of the three Schools received an established Oak Tree, courtesy of Ferring Nurseries, to plant in their grounds, together with a smaller Oak Tree, donated by the Brookside Memorial Garden Community Group.

The Manager of Rustington Museum has now made arrangements for all of the entries, together with the 'Heads and Shoulders' Silhouettes representing those from Rustington who gave their lives during World War One, which featured as part of the Rustington Remembrance Sunday Service at the War Memorial on 11 November 2018, to be displayed in the area, soon to be home to Rustington Museum, at The Samuel Wickens Centre, in the Broadmark Lane Car Park. It is anticipated that the entries will be on display, during the Centre's opening hours, for members of the public to view for a period of two weeks, with effect from Wednesday

5 December 2018.
