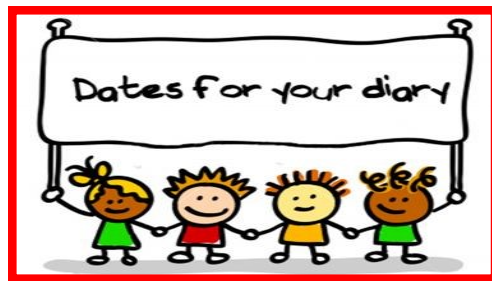

We are delighted to offer your child a free steelpan taster session. Our come and have a go session will take place on Thursday 13 September from 3.15 – 3.50 in the music room. Children will learn about the different steelpans and learn to play a simple song on either the steelpans or drum kit. Parents are very welcome to arrive five minutes before the end of the session to hear us perform.

If your child would then like to join steelband club, we run weekly sessions on Thursday from 3.15 – 4.00. Your child will receive expert tuition from a qualified teacher (PGCE) and will have the opportunity to perform at Sussex Steel and school events.
