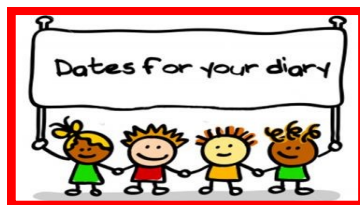

Cheerleading: Weds 8-8:45am, 27th Feb – 3rd April (6 weeks,) Years 1-6, £14.99

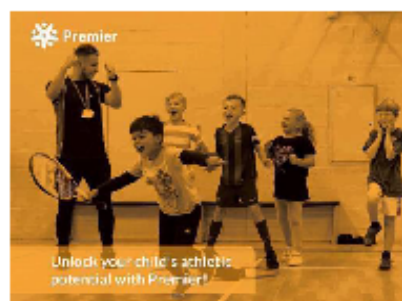
